

# WINDSOR-SEVERANCE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

## BOARD OF DIRECTOR CANDIDATE PACKET

The Windsor-Severance Fire Protection District is a governmental subdivision of the State of Colorado and a body corporate possessing those powers of a quasi-municipal corporation, which are specifically authorized by, and in compliance with, Section 32-1-101, et seq., CRS.

Windsor-Severance Fire Protection District was formed as a special district in 1950. The district encompasses about 110 square miles between the approximate boundaries of: I-25 to the west; WCR 29 to the east; WCR 86 to the north and Hwy 34 to the south. The district lies within Weld and Larimer counties.

The district is governed by a (five member) Board of Directors who are elected by the residents of the district and serve staggered four year terms. Currently, the Board meets once a month (on the third Thursday) at 7:00 p.m. with additional work sessions required during peak strategic and financial decision making times of the year. Meetings will usually last 2-3 hours. Compensation is paid (per state statute) at the rate of \$100.00 per meeting; with a yearly cap of \$1,600.00.

"It shall be the policy of the Windsor-Severance Fire Protection District Board of Directors, consistent with the availability of revenues, personnel and equipment to provide fire protection, rescue, emergency medical services, hazardous materials response and life safety services."

The DEO will notify all candidates of the date, time and location of the lot drawing to be held to determine placement of candidate names on the ballot.

All new board members are required to complete an extensive director orientation.
